## The Network Beyond Ft. Wayne

What’s more, PHCS Savility is available to members on a national basis. When seeking care outside the Ft. Wayne area, PHCS Savility members automatically have access to all other PHCS Savility providers, and to PHCS Network and HealthEOS providers outside PHCS Savility markets. This means that, outside Ft. Wayne, PHCS Savility members have access to approximately 4,200 more hospitals, 70,000 more ancillary facilities and 640,000 more practitioners across the country.
