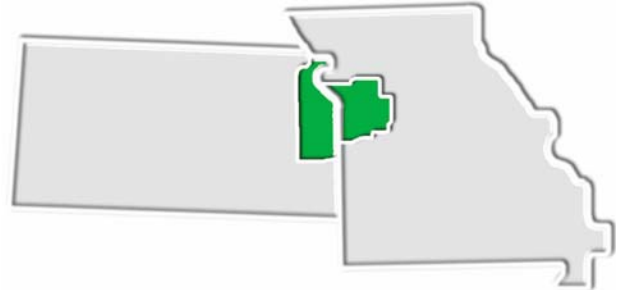




Market Profile Kansas City
